**What We Will Pay and When**

- You will receive RSDI of \$543.90 around CM/01/CY.
- These are the amounts of your monthly Social Security benefits.

There are no changes to the way you receive your monthly payments.

We must make payment on the first of the month to everyone entitled on a Social Security record whenever anyone on that record;

- receives Supplemental Security Income (SSI) payments, or railroad retirement payments, or
- has income and/or resources considered when determine whether an SSI claimant is eligible for benefits, or
- moves outside the U.S., or
- has Medicare premiums paid by the state, or
- has payments garnished.

## Your Benefit Amount

By law Social Security benefits increase automatically to keep pace with inflation. When there is period of no inflation, the law does not permit an increase in benefits. If there is no increase based on the Consumer Price Index (CPI) published by the Department of Labor, there will be no rise in the cost of living during the past year, so your benefit will remain the same. If there is an increase, you will receive notification from our office. The CPI is the federal government's official measure used to calculate cost-of-living increases.

Please review the other important information in this mailing. You can use this letter when you need proof of your benefit amount to receive food stamps, rent subsidies, energy assistance, bank loans, or for other business.

### How Much Will I Get And When?

- Your monthly amount of RSDI (before deductions) is \$684.20
- The cost of living adjustment (COLA) increase \$0.00
- Start Date: CM/01/1 year ago. The amount we are deducting for Medicare Part A medical insurance \$0.00
- Start Date: CM/01/1 year ago. The amount we are deducting for Medicare Part B medical insurance \$104.90
- The amount we are deducting for your Medicare prescription drug plan is \$35.40  
You are currently enrolled in Cigna Medicare RX Plan One.
- The amount we are deducting for voluntary federal tax withholding is \$0.00
- After taking any other deductions, we will deposit \$543.90  
into your bank account.
