

QUALIFIED AND NONQUALIFIED NONCITIZENS

Qualified Noncitizens

Resided in U.S. for at least five years:

- Lawful Permanent Residents
- Immigrants granted parole for at least one year
- Battered noncitizens and their children
- Noncitizens who currently receive SSI or RSDI or have otherwise been certified as blind or disabled by SSA or SMRT

Regardless of date of entry into U.S.:

- Honorably discharged noncitizen U.S. veterans **or** noncitizens on active duty, their spouses, & unmarried dependent children
- American Indians born in Canada who are at least 50%

American Indian, including their adopted children who are at least 50% Indian

- Refugees
- Asylees
- Immigrants whose deportation has been withheld
- Conditional Entrants
- Cuban/Haitian entrants
- Amerasian entrants
- Members of a federally recognized Indian tribe born outside the U.S.
- People certified by the Office of Refugee Resettlement as Victims of Trafficking
- Afghan and Iraqi Special Immigrants
- Lawfully present noncitizen pregnant women and children

Nonqualified Noncitizens (non-pregnant adults only)

Resided in U.S. for less than five years:

- Lawful Permanent Residents
- Immigrants granted parole for at least one year
- Battered noncitizens

Regardless of date of entry:

Includes, but is not limited to the following groups:

- Deferred Enforced Departure
- Family Unity Beneficiary
- Lawful Temporary Resident
- Temporary Protected Status
- Applicant for Asylum
- Paroled into U.S. for less than one year
